Admissions Policy

Undergraduate Admissions

Ritsumeikan Asia Pacific University (APU) welcomes students who will uphold the university's basic ideals of Freedom, Peace, and Humanity, International Mutual Understanding, and the Future Shape of the Asia Pacific Region. These should also, while using both English and Japanese, be ready to acknowledge and understand differences in cultures and values, engage actively in an international campus community, and contribute to mutual learning.

New undergraduate students must possess the following attributes and abilities in order to engage in this kind of learning:

- 1) Knowledge and Skills
 - Basic knowledge required for studying at university
 - English or Japanese language proficiency required to pursue university-level studies
- 2) Reasoning, Judgement, and Expression
 - Critical thinking, analytical ability, and creativity needed to identify problems and proactively work towards their resolution
 - Ability to interpret information accurately, as well as express one's own ideas clearly and logically using facts and data
- 3) Initiative and Capacity to Collaborate with Individuals from Diverse Backgrounds
 - Ability to pursue goals and follow them through
 - Readiness to engage with and support others on the basis of mutual understanding
 - Desire to make full use of a multicultural learning environment and participate in multicultural collaborative learning

College of Asia Pacific Studies

- 1) Interest in one of the fields of "Culture, Society, and Media", "International Relations", and "Global Economy" in global society with a focus on the Asia Pacific region
- 2) Basic ability to study the field social sciences with a focus on society, politics, and economics
- 3) Ability to read and write basic texts that will lead to reading and writing specialized texts at College of Asia Pacific Studies
- 4) Ability to pursue one's own interests and to express them clearly
- 5) Ability to integrate large amounts of information and think from multiple angles when framing opinions

92% of domestic students live in dormitories

All students who wish to live in the dormitory can do so for one year after enrollment. Dormitory applications can only be made at the time of APU application. For more information about AP House, please scan the QR code.



Dormitory Fee Reduction System

This is a system that subsidizes half of the AP House dormitory fees to provide financial support after enrollment (maximum of 60 students). Applications must be made within a separate period from the application period.

* 2 Dormitory fees: (Breakdown) For students enrolling in April, April 2025 fee is 52,000 yen, for students enrolling in May is 52,000 yen (AP House 5 base). For students enrolling in September, half a month's fee in September 2025 is 26,000 yen, for students enrolling in October is 52,000 yen, for students enrolling in November is 26,000 yen (AP House 5 standard). For students enrolling in AP House 1 or 2, the difference will be deducted from the dormitory fees paid after moving in.

05 | Select your preference for the Domestic Students Academic Excellence Scholarship

Full exemption of tuition fees for four years

The scholarship will be awarded to students with outstanding results in the entrance examination, based on a comprehensive evaluation of the applicant's application documents, including external English Language Proficiency Test scores, and the ability to fulfill the APU2030 Vision and Admissions Policy. Applicants must choose whether or not they wish to receive this scholarship at the time of application. Full tuition of 5.8 million yen (estimated) will be exempted for up to four years. Whether or not you wish to receive the scholarship will not affect your acceptance or rejection. If you are selected to receive this scholarship, you will not be restricted from applying to or enrolling in other universities.

06 | Choose a "Language Basis" that suits your English ability

It does not matter if you are not comfortable with English at the time of application. Please make your choice according to your English ability.

What is Language Basis?

One of the unique features of APU's education is the "Japanese-English Dual Language Education" program, in which classes are offered in both Japanese and English. Prospective students are required to select either the "Japanese basis" or the "English basis" as their base language of admission at the time of application. At the time of admission, all new students take a placement test in the language opposite to the base language, and based on the results, begin taking required language courses at the appropriate level for their abilities (except for students admitted in the third year).

Japanese-basis

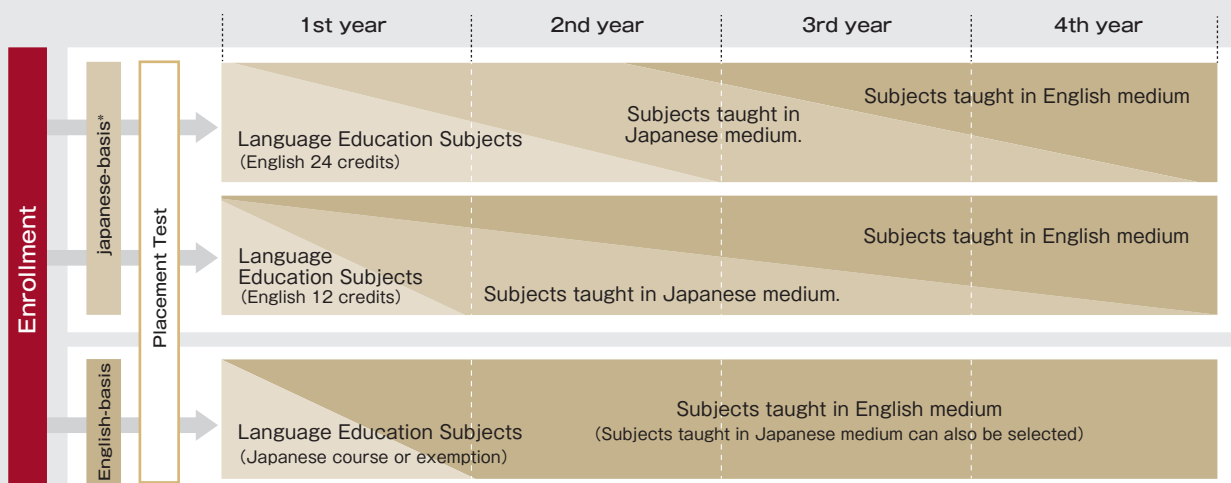
The majority of domestic students who have graduated from high schools in Japan take the entrance examination and are admitted on the Japanese language basis. Japanese basis domestic students take mainly Japanese-language common education courses and major subjects in their first or second year. At the same time, students will take English language education courses and aim to take major courses offered in English, gradually increasing the number of courses offered in English as their English skills improve. For Japanese basis students in Japan, there are no English proficiency requirements for application depending on the entrance application type, but the standard English proficiency level at the time of admission is 45–61 on the TOEFL iBT® Test, 5.0–5.5 on the IELTS (Academic Module), or 1980 or above on the EIKEN® CSE2.0. The minimum score for the EIKEN® CSE2.0 is 1980. For Japanese basis domestic students, the graduation requirement is 20 credits or more in English-language common education courses or major courses (124 credits required for graduation).

English-basis

Students will take English-language common education courses and major courses from the beginning of their enrollment. This program is suitable for students who have received education in English at the equivalent of junior or senior high school, or who have studied abroad in an English-speaking country for an extended period of time.

For domestic students who enter as first-year students and meet the English language standards, the application requirements include a TOEFL iBT® Test score of 75 or higher, but the average English proficiency level of applicants is 80–100 on the TOEFL iBT® Test and 6.0–6.5 on the IELTS (Academic Module) and 2304 or higher on the Eiken® CSE 2.0 score. For students admitted under English basis, the language education course "English" is not required, but some "English" courses may be accepted as elective courses.

* Students with Japanese basis can also take classes in English medium from the beginning if they start with a pre-advanced English language class as their language education subject (equivalent to IELTS 6.0).

Purpose

The purpose of this entrance examination is to accept applicants who are highly interested in the academic field of each college they wish to apply for, who are highly motivated to study after admission, and who have the potential for growth after admission. This examination is recommended to applicants with the following characteristics.

- Those who are confident about their achievement of significant growth through activities since graduating from junior high school.
- Those who have performed outstanding activities in various fields after graduating from junior high school, such as international experience, studying abroad, language, research, academics, culture, art, sports, volunteering, etc.
- Those who want to utilize their abilities and experience cultivated through ambitious efforts to enhance their studies and extracurricular activities after enrollment.

- English language ability

- Essay: Achievements and reflections on academics and extracurricular activities during high school, etc.

Applicants must fulfill all of the conditions (1), (2) and (3). In addition, English basis applicants must also meet (4).

- (1) Those who have an interest and eagerness to study at the preferred college.
- (2) Those who have graduated from high school (including secondary education school) or are expected to graduate, and have university entrance qualifications.
- (3) Those who have engaged in one or more of the outstanding activities listed in Table (1) to (8) on P12 since graduating from junior high school.

[English basis applicants only]

- (4) Those who meet any of the following ① to ③ regarding English proficiency.

- ① Those with a TOEFL iBT® Test score equivalent to 75 points or higher.
- ② Those who have obtained or are expected to obtain an International Baccalaureate (IB) diploma in English.
- ③ Those who have sufficient English proficiency, such as having all the basic education subjects (excluding language education subjects) in English during the period equivalent to the curriculum of Japanese junior high and high schools, or those who are native in English.

Countermeasure

- Even shortterm study abroad programs of 3 months or more can be evaluated. Let's show off the language skills you achieved through studying abroad by getting a qualification.
- You can also highlight your achievements in multiple activities, such as language qualifications and winning awards in club activities.
- If you have experience presenting research activities that you worked on at school or independently at a research group, please highlight them.
- Even if you don't have a language qualification, if you have a track record in other activities, you can appeal.
- In your essay, reflect on yourself and specifically express how you have grown through your experiences and how you were able to overcome difficulties.
- During the interview, it is important to highlight your reasons for applying and appeal your activities, but you should also practice expressing your opinions by keeping an eye on the social situation of the country or place you live.

[Evidence of Activities]

For the abovementioned activities, it is not necessary to have a track record of winning or receiving awards, but **proof of the activity must include activity details, identification of the applicant and proof of the date**. Please note that the certification must be issued by the organization that conducted the activity, or objectively verified by a third party. Please note that there is no need to submit any certificates on the completion of the UNITE Program by our university. Additionally, there is no specification of the format of the certificate. Regarding certificates for individual activities, even if you ask the university whether they qualify as achievements or certifications, we cannot answer. Applicants should submit the proofs on their own judgment.

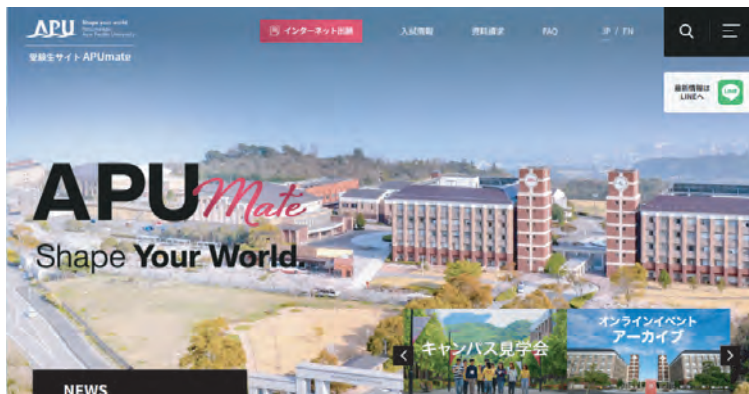
