

2nd Year Transfer

1. College of International Management (APM)

(1) Graduation Requirements

If an applicant transfers into APM in their second year, they must fulfill the following requirements in order to graduate.

- Complete a total of at least 124 credits (including credits transferred to APU).
- Complete all required language subjects.
- Fulfill credit requirements for each subject field.
- Complete all required APM subjects.

(2) Credit Transfer

Second year transfer students may transfer up to 30 credits in the Common Education subject fields. If you have acquired APM required subjects in the Common Liberal Arts subject field (“Introduction to Economics” and “Statistics”) in AACSB, EQUIS, AMBA or EPAS accredited schools, you do not have to take them after your enrollment to APU.

2. College of Asia Pacific Studies (APS)

(1) Graduation Requirements

If an applicant transfers into APS in their second year, they must fulfill the following requirements in order to graduate.

- Complete a total of at least 124 credits (including credits transferred to APU).
- Complete all required language subjects.
- Complete at least 2 credits from the requires subjects which you registered for your Area of Study.
- Complete at least 28 credits from the Major Education Subjects for your registered Area of Study.

(2) Credit Transfer

Second year transfer students may transfer up to 30 credits in the Common Education subject fields. Once you enter APU, you will be required to take “Introduction to APS” which is a Core subject of APS.
